

## **Notice of Public Hearing**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Public Hearing will be held Friday, August 29, 2025 at 6:00 p.m., at the Town of Merton Town Hall, located at W314N7624 Hwy 83, North Lake, Wisconsin 53064.

On July 30, 2025, a petition was filed with the Waukesha County Clerk, requesting the establishment of a public inland lake protection and rehabilitation district, to be known as the Moose Lake District ("District"), pursuant to Chapter 33 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

The boundary of the proposed District is generally described to include all lands abutting Moose Lake, located in the Town of Merton.

Pursuant to sec. 33.26, Wisconsin Statutes, at the hearing, all interested persons may offer objections, criticisms, or suggestions as to the necessity of the proposed District as outlined and question whether their property will be benefited by the establishment of the District. Any person wishing to object to the organization of the District may, before the date set for the hearing, file objections to the formation of the District with the Waukesha County Clerk in Room AC 120, 515 W. Moreland Blvd., Waukesha, WI 53188.

The public hearing will be facilitated by the Waukesha County Department of Parks and Land Use and designated County representatives on behalf of the Waukesha County Land Use, Parks and Environment Committee. A quorum of the Waukesha County Land Use, Parks and Environment Committee may be present, but no action will be taken by the committee. A brief informational presentation will precede the public hearing.
